**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER THE ESTABLISHMENT  
OF A BROWNFIELD REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY AND TO  
DESIGNATE THE BOUNDARIES OF A BROWNFIELD  
REDEVELOPMENT ZONE**

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that the City Council of the City of Lowell will hold a public hearing to consider the establishment of a brownfield redevelopment authority and to designate the boundaries of a brownfield redevelopment zone pursuant to the Brownfield Redevelopment Financing Act, Act 381 of the Public Acts of Michigan of 1996, as amended (“Act 381”).

The proposed boundaries of the brownfield redevelopment zone would include all of the property within the jurisdictional limits of the City.

**TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that the public hearing will be held at 7:00 p.m., local time, on Monday, August 20<sup>th</sup> 2018, in the City Hall, 310 E. Main Street in the City of Lowell, Kent County, Michigan, at which time any resident, taxpayer, official from a taxing jurisdiction whose millage may be subject to capture under a brownfield plan as defined in Act 381, or property owner within the City will be given the opportunity to be heard regarding the establishment of the brownfield redevelopment authority and the designation of the boundaries of the proposed brownfield redevelopment zone.
