

MINUTES OF THE LOWELL AIRPORT BOARD
THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 7, 2008, AT 7:00 P.M.

Present: Grimm, Nicholls and Vezino.

Absent: Hale, Myaard, Nelson and Sowle.

Also Present: Dave Pasquale, Howard Van Horn, Gail Hohbach, Penny Deshaw and Jason Clark.

No formal meeting was held since no quorum was present. A discussion had been held concerning the following:

Jason Clark of URS provided an update on tree cutting at the airport. The contractor has the four east parcels almost done.

Removal of the pines between the two runways was discussed with neighbors Gail Hohback and Penny Deshaw who were against the removal. They noted the wetlands and these were nice, old trees.

Clark stated this is a safety issue and one dictated by the State. The tree cutting in this area will proceed.

The nearby radio tower (Giberson property) was discussed and the need for this to be moved.

It had been also noted for the glide slope of runway 30 needs to be lengthened 100 feet so several trees in the State Game Area east of the airport must be removed or topped.

Wood chips are available for the Department of Public Works.

The session was recessed at 8:17 p.m.
